

RULES FOR ARRIVALS FROM COUNTRIES WITH A RISK OF THE EMERGENCE OF A NEW VARIANT OF THE CORONAVIRUS

Due to the emergence of a new variant of the coronavirus, the Government of the Czech Republic has adopted a crisis measure with effect from 27 November 2021 which **prohibits the entry into the Czech Republic of all third-country nationals who have spent at least 12 hours in one of the countries listed below in the last 14 days**. The exception is given only to holders of a permission for a stay over 90 days in the territory of the Czech Republic issued by the Czech Republic.

If you are a citizen of the Czech Republic or a foreigner with the permission for a stay for more than 90 days in the Czech Republic and you are coming from one of the following countries:



The Republic of South Africa



The Republic of Zimbabwe



The Republic of Namibia



The Republic of Botswana



The Kingdom of Lesotho



The Republic of Zambia



The Kingdom of Eswatini



The Republic of Mozambique

You are obliged to fulfil these conditions*:

Before entering the Czech Republic:

- 1) Fill in the Passenger Locator Form
- 2) Have a negative PCR test result that has not been performed more than 72 hours before the beginning of the travel
- 3) Have a confirmation of booking for a PCR test to be carried out within 24 hours after the arrival

After the arrival in the Czech Republic:

- 1) Undergo a PCR test within 24 hours after the arrival
- 2) Undergo self-isolation until a negative PCR test result is available; test must be taken between 10th and 14th day after the arrival
- 3) Wear a respirator or similar protection (without an exhalation filter) meeting at least all technical conditions and requirements (for the product), including a filtration efficiency of at least 95% according to the relevant standards (e.g. FFP2, KN95) for 14 days after arrival

**THESE CONDITIONS APPLY TO ALL PERSONS, INCLUDING VACCINATED PERSONS
AND PERSONS WHO HAVE RECOVERED FROM A COVID 19.**

* exceptions to the above rules are for international transport staff and children under 6 years of age who do not attend pre-school
