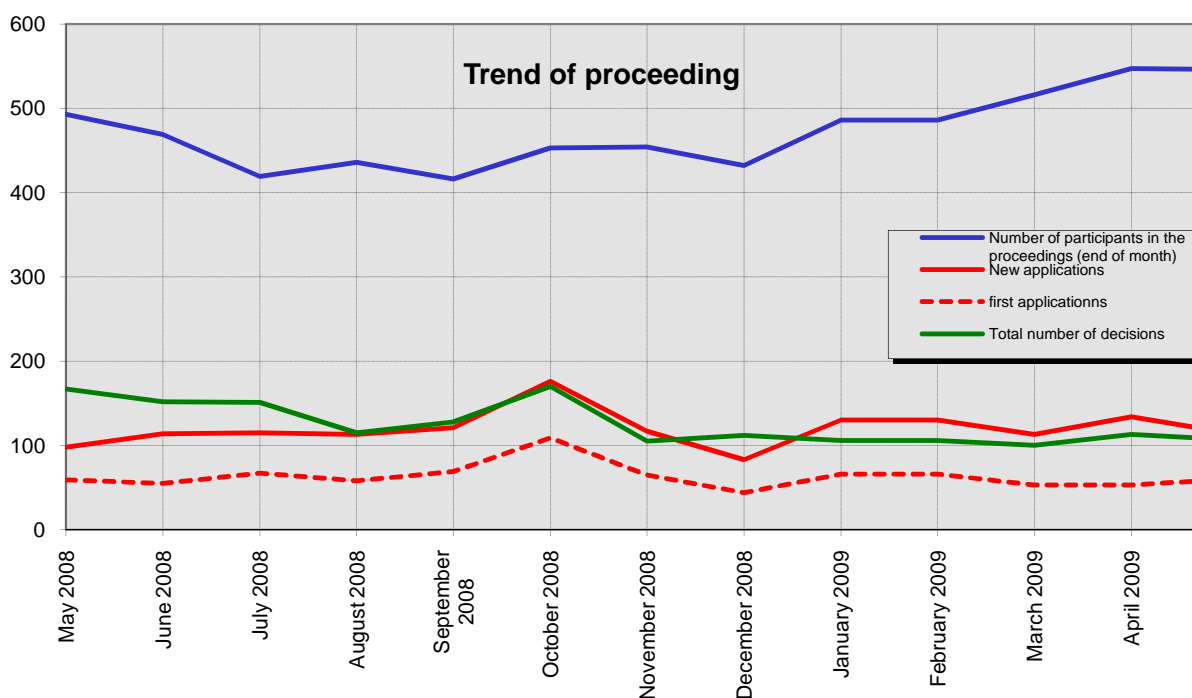

*** **Served decisions** = this column also contains older decisions which were served on international protection seekers during the given period being served with the decision the person stops being an international protection seeker in the First Instance of the Asylum Procedure.
