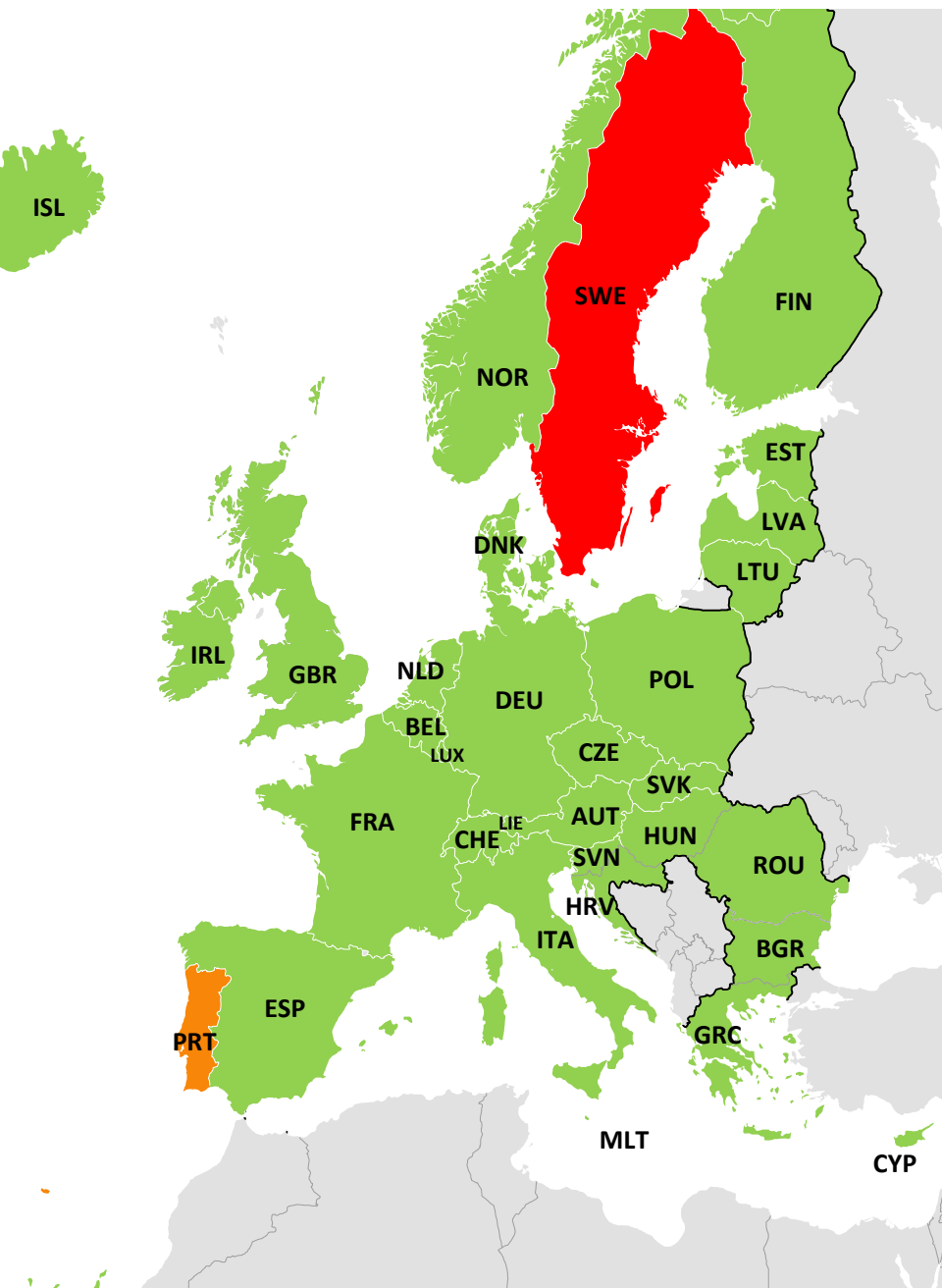


# Entry to the Czech Republic after 15. 6. 2020 (update 30. 6.)

Country or its part	the risk level and related measures
Sweden	<p><b>high risk</b></p> <p>Czech citizens and residents in CZE – test or quarantine are necessary upon return to CZE</p> <p>citizens and residents* of the country – entry ban of foreign nationals to CZE, exceptions are defined by the Ministry of Health Protective Measure</p> <p>* in case of Czech citizens residing in the country, test or quarantine are necessary for travel to CZE</p>
Portugal	<p><b>medium risk</b></p> <p>Czech citizens and residents in CZE – test or quarantine are not necessary upon return to CZE</p> <p>citizens and residents* of the country – entry ban of foreign nationals to CZE, exceptions are defined by the Ministry of Health Protective Measure</p> <p>* in case of Czech citizens residing in the country, test or quarantine are necessary for travel to CZE</p>
