



Dear clients,

from 4th of January 2021 till 17th of January 2021 the Migration office in Brno is completely closed due to its moving to different place. Immigration office will be open from 18th of January 2021 at the address: Tuřanka 115, Brno. Collection of biometric data for the purposes of residence permits cards or Alien's passports will be terminated already on 17th of December 2020

For this reason:

1. Reporting obligation, i.e. registration of foreign nationals after their arrival to the territory of the Czech Republic including the collection of biometric data, will be carried out as from 18th of January 2021. Non-compliance with the time limits for registration due to the closure of the Migration office in Brno, will not be sanctioned.

2. In the period from 4th of January 2021 till 17th of January 2021 the Confirmation of Fulfillment of Conditions for the issue of the employee card, blue card or ICT card will be issued only based on the written request made either by employer or foreign national himself.

3. Till 17th of January 2021, please, use still the address: Hněvkovského 30/65, 617 00 Brno, for the written contact with Migration office in Brno.

4. Urgent matters (for instance issue of the Departure Order) can be treated by other migration offices; for instance in Jihlava, Zlín or Přerov. In such a case, please follow the conditions of entry to the premises of these migration offices, stated in "Kontakty" field.

5. Applications for residence permits that must be submitted in person [i.e. application for the issue of the long-term residence permit (including employee card), application for temporary residence permit, application for permanent residence permit, application for issue or for prolongation of the leave to remain long-term visa] you can submit as from 18th of January 2021. Please do not send such applications by post or via databox of the Ministry of Interior, otherwise they will be returned to you. Fact that Migration office in Brno is closed will be considered as the objective obstacle that hindered you from applying in the time (where the application must be submitted in person). Same applies if you were asked to provide original of the document that is not possible to send by mail (for instance travel document).

6. If you had some general questions relating to the residence of the foreign nationals on the territory of the Czech Republic, please address your question to the Central information line of Ministry of Interior, number 974 820 680. Please be informed that from 4th of January 2021 till 17th of January 2021 will not be possible to book an appointment at the Migration office in Brno by telephone.
