

CLIENTS ACCESS TO THE OFFICES OF THE MINISTRY OF THE INTERIOR OF THE CZECH REPUBLIC AS OF SEPTEMBER 25TH, 2021



clients arriving from:

- countries with a **low and medium risk** of infection - may enter the Mol office facility with an (antigen or RT-PCR) test performed within five days of entry; vaccinated persons with a recognized certificate and persons who contracted COVID-19 more than 11 and less than 180 days ago may enter without restriction

if they have a recognized certificate.

- countries with **high risk** may enter the Mol office with (RT-PCR) test performed no earlier than on the 5th and no later than on the 14th day after entering the territory; exceptions are vaccinated persons and persons who have had the disease.
- countries with a **very high risk** of infection may enter the Mol office with a (RT-PCR) test performed no earlier than on the 5th and no later than on the 14th day after entering the territory; exceptions are vaccinated persons and persons who have had the disease.

A person is considered infection-free if he or she had COVID-19 more than 11 but less than 180 days ago.

WHAT TO DO IF I AM POSITIVE?

In case of a positive result of the RT-PCR test, please, do not arrive at the MoI office until the very end of the ordered quarantine measure.

WHAT IF I WILL NOT FULFILL THE REPORTING OBLIGATION DUE TO THE TEST?

If you fail to comply with the reporting obligation due to the protection measure (i. e. you will not report the arrival to the territory within 3 working days from the date of entry), **no sanction will be imposed on you**. However, you must subsequently fulfill this obligation in person as soon as possible.



Make an appointment in advance to visit the Mol office and use only

respirator or disposable medical mask (surgical mask).

Persons with other than the stated protection of the mouth and nose will not be checked in, as well as persons who come to the Mol office before the end of any quarantine measure.
